Flue Adapter

Used to connect the flexible chimney liner to single wall pipe at the base of the stack.

Register Plate Flue Adapter

This can be used in place of the MA adaptor and is particularly useful for installing a stove or boiler in to a tight opening. The liner is fitted into the adapter part, the flat plate is then fixed to the debris or register plate. The whole chimney liner can be finished at the connection to the appliance can be made later using an adjustable length of pipe or a vitreous pipe. Also removal of the appliance is made simple. The plate measures 10 inch square (250mm).

Increasing Adapter 100mm Rigid Pipe to 125mm Flex

Used to connect the flexible chimney liner to a smaller diameter single wall pipe at the base of the stack.

Top Plate

This plate sits at the top of the stack and, used in conjunction with a Top Clamp provides the required support.

Top Clamp

The clamp sits on top of the Top Plate and clamps the liner tightly.

Top Insert Sleeve

Slides inside the flexible chimney liner at the top of the installation and is used together with the Top Plate and Top Clamp. It provides rigid internal support for the top clamp when clamping the liner. It also stops damage to the top of the liner caused by brushing. Because liners are spirally wound in manufacture they could be damaged by brushes when being swept.

Pot Hanger

The Pot Hanger allows the chimney liner to be installed without removing the pot. It is used at the top of the chimney pot to take the weight of the liner, simply push the liner between the three straps and tighten the supplied jubilee band. The pot hanger also has a further three straps which hang down the outside of the chimney pot. The jubilee band supplied is fixed around these to secure against the pot. The standard pot hanger can be useful where a downdraught is suspected as it can be used to hang the liner from the top of the pot and then an anti-downdraught cowl can be fitted.

Pot Hanger with Rain Cap & Mesh

The Pot Hanging Cowl has four functions;

- (1) Allows the chimney liner to be installed without removing the pot.
- (2) Provides rain protection at the top of the stack.
- (3) The straps on the outside provide a clamping system to the chimney pot.
- (4) The mesh provides security from birds.

Pot Hanger with Anti-downdraught Cowl

The Pot Hanger with integral anti-downdraught cowl is the ultimate in chimney liner suspending cowls. Not only allowing the chimney liner to be installed without removing the pot, but prevents any downdraught and increased rain protection.

Rain Cap

Provides rain protection at the top of the stack. This cowl has a clamped fixing system, which grips tightly around the chimney liner as it protrudes through the top plate.

Nose Cone

Helps prevent snagging against the side of the stack and also provides a draw cord (not supplied) from which the liner can be guided down.

Joiner

Used to connect two pieces of flexible liner.

Vermiclite

The insulating properties of Vermiculit significantly reduce the loss of heat in cold weather and keep the interior cool in hot weather. Vermiculite is clean to handle, non-abrasive, sound absorbent, resistant to decay, odourless & non-irritant.
